#### School Exclusion—Don't Get Left Behind!

Nearly every place that provides care for a child outside the home requires shots or a medical or non-medical exemption to stay enrolled. This year, the School Exclusion date is Wednesday, February 15. Students attending school or daycare who do not have documentation of required immunizations or an exemption on file will not be allowed to attend until documentation is received by the school or child care facility.

Immunization providers, including the Marion County Health Department, can get very busy near the school exclusion date. Waiting until the last minute to immunize for school can be a frustrating experience for parents and students trying to make appointments for shots and some-

times results in extremely long wait times in a crowded waiting room. Here are a few tips to help avoid the inconvenience of a student being excluded from school:

Contact your provider to see if your student needs any shots for school.

Make an appointment for shots well in advance of School Exclusion Day.

Bring your immunization records to your appointment.

#### Winter River Safety Tips

The Jefferson Fire District would like to advise residents to avoid recreation in the Santiam River during heavy rainfall and near flooding conditions. This includes any of the following:

• Water skiing • Jet skiing • Swimming • Fishing • Boating • Stay away from the edge

The river flows vary and will run faster than normal during heavy rainfall and other weather related conditions. There is usually more debris than normal floating down the river and at a faster pace. The debris can also be larger than normal. Typically, after a heavy rainfall the river will continue to rise for approximately 48 hours after the rain has stopped. The fire district does have a limited supply of sand bags please call the office at 541-327-2822 if you are in need of some. Do not hesitate to call 911 during an emergency. Your safety is our first and foremost concern.
