
Help Shape the Future of Our Region's Travel AAMPO Seeks Input on Draft Transportation Project Lists

Backyard Burning

The backyard burning season is open beginning March 1, 2016 until June 15, 2016. After June 15, 2016 agriculture burning will be allowed on a day-to-day basis determined by DEQ. For the daily burning advisory, call (877) 982-0011 to make sure it is a "burn day". Agriculture permits are no longer required however you must still comply as an agricultural operator under Oregon's burn laws. A brochure explaining the law can be obtained at the Jefferson Fire District office Monday – Friday 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m or on-line at www.deq.state.or.us. For more information, call the fire district at (541) 327-2822. For burn complaints you may call 1-888-997-7888.

The DEQ has the authority under state law to prohibit open burning anywhere in the state on a day to day basis.
